Description: The VCHRI Clinical Research Unit (CRU) is accepting applications for in-kind services to develop pilot studies at VCHRI.

The CRU will provide successful applicants with assistance in the development of the pilot study protocol, study budget, ethics submission, recruitment, study conduct, and data collection. The Centre for Clinical Epidemiology and Evaluation (C2E2) will assist the investigator with study design and data analysis.

Assessment Criteria: Pilot Studies must meet the following criteria:

The goal is to acquire the preliminary data needed to support a larger scale grant application, or to demonstrate feasibility of a larger study;

Recruitment and study procedures must be completed in 8 to 12 months.

The study may be a proof of concept study to determine if an intervention shows an effect. Or alternatively, it is a study to demonstrate the feasibility of one or more of recruitment, of the delivery of a complex intervention, of feasibility of data collection, etc.

Who Should Apply?

This assistance is open to VCH and UBC investigators with VCH affiliated status.

Registration Deadline:

Applications must be received by Wednesday, February 15.

Funding Available:

The CRU will provide preliminary services (i.e. protocol development, budget, ethics application) and clinical services (i.e. recruitment, study visits, data collection) for each successful pilot study application with an expectation of in-kind services equal to \$2000 to \$4000. Two pilot studies will be funded

Location:

The CRU is located on the 4th floor of the Gordon and Leslie Diamond Health Care Centre. Study visits can take place in the offices and exam rooms of the CRU.

III) March 30: The Alton Ochsner Award Relating Smoking and Disease

An annual award of \$15,000 will be presented to one to three investigators for outstanding and exemplary original scientific investigations that relate tobacco consumption with disease. This scientific work may be clinical, fundamental, epidemiological or prevention in scope. The prime criterion for award selection is its scientific context and impact on this major health threat. All nominations, whatever the category of scientific inquiry, must be supported by letters and copies of peer-reviewed scientific publications as detailed below.

Institutional Sponsor: Ochsner Clinic Foundation

Nominations:

Nominations must be made by a letter that describes in detail, but concisely, the scientific work and major contributions of the investigator to the field. Self-nominations are excluded.

All nominations must include and be supported by:

- (1) The Candidate's CV (containing active mailing address, office and mobile telephone numbers, email address and bibliography);
- (2) at least two additional supporting letters of recommendation by scientific peers from outside the candidate's institution;
- (3) reprints of at least three pertinent major scientific contributions.

The Award Committee is now accepting nominations and supporting material in PDF format only by email sent to Ochsner at AOSRA@ochsner.org.

Document submitted in a format other than PDF by e-mail will not be considered. No books or bound journals will be accepted with the nomination. Each nominee will be restricted to a one three year term; and the candidate must wait at least two years before being proposed again. Any nominees not receiving the Award will automatically be considered for the two remaining years. Submission of additional supporting letters and updated materials are strongly recommended.

Deadline for Nominations: Nominations must be submitted via e-mail as attached documents in PDF format, emailed to AOSRA@ochsner.org no later than March 30, 2012.
